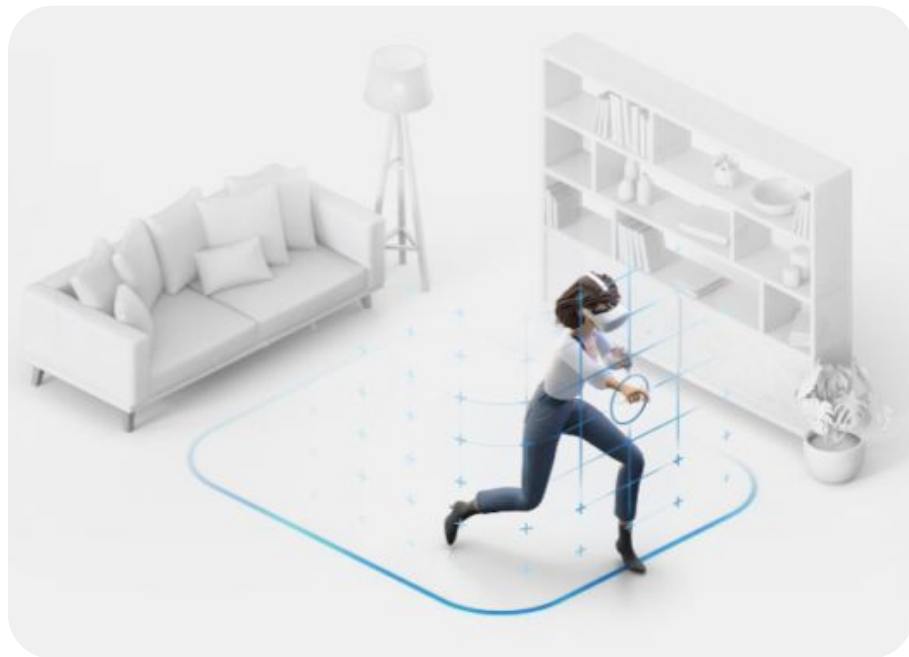




VR Induction



Trainees do not need to move



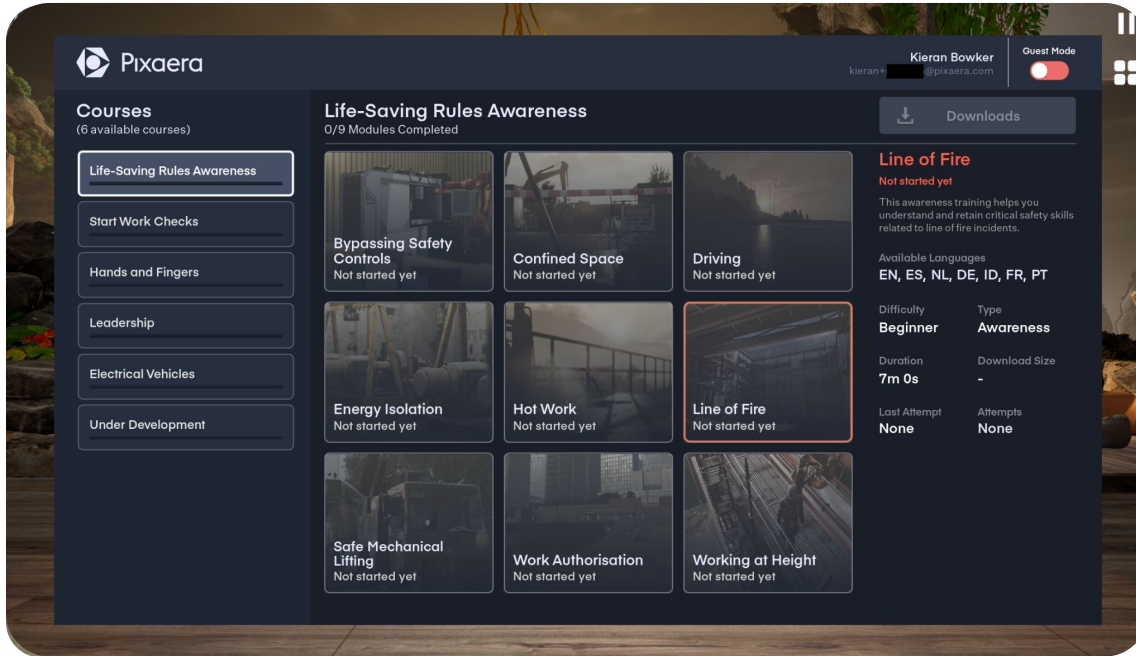
- Let the trainee know that they do not need to move their feet and walk around.
- Although there is a stationary boundary/guardian in place, it is not something that should be relied upon, hence the importance of emphasising that walking is not necessary as part of the training.

Provide the controllers first



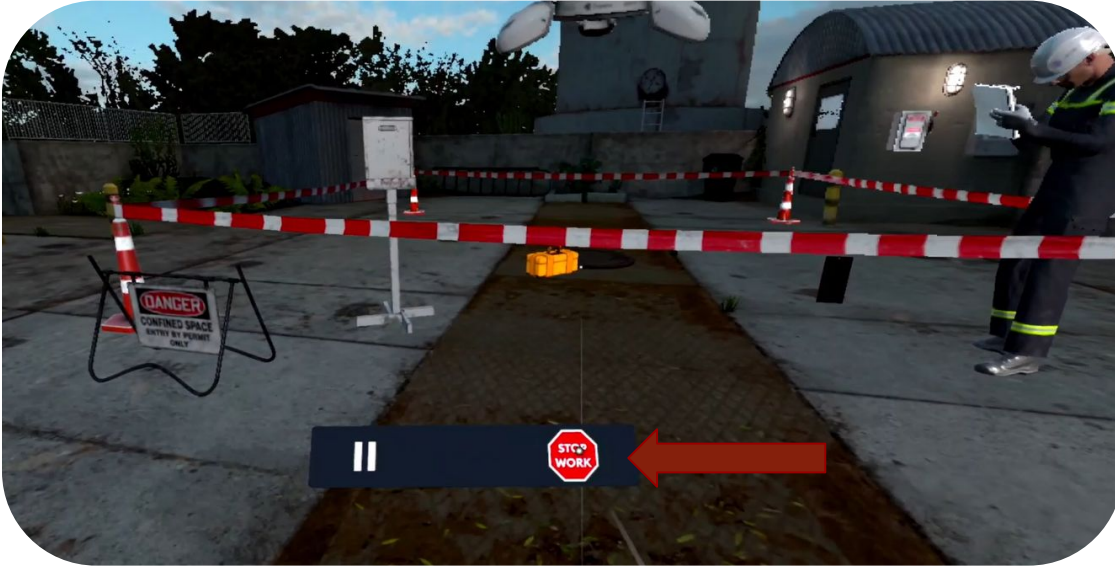
- Hand over the controllers to the trainee before assisting them with the headset.
- Highlight the trigger button they will need to interact with throughout the training – this is the **only** button they will need to use.
- Trainees will use this button to point, drag and drop

Pixaera lobby screen loaded



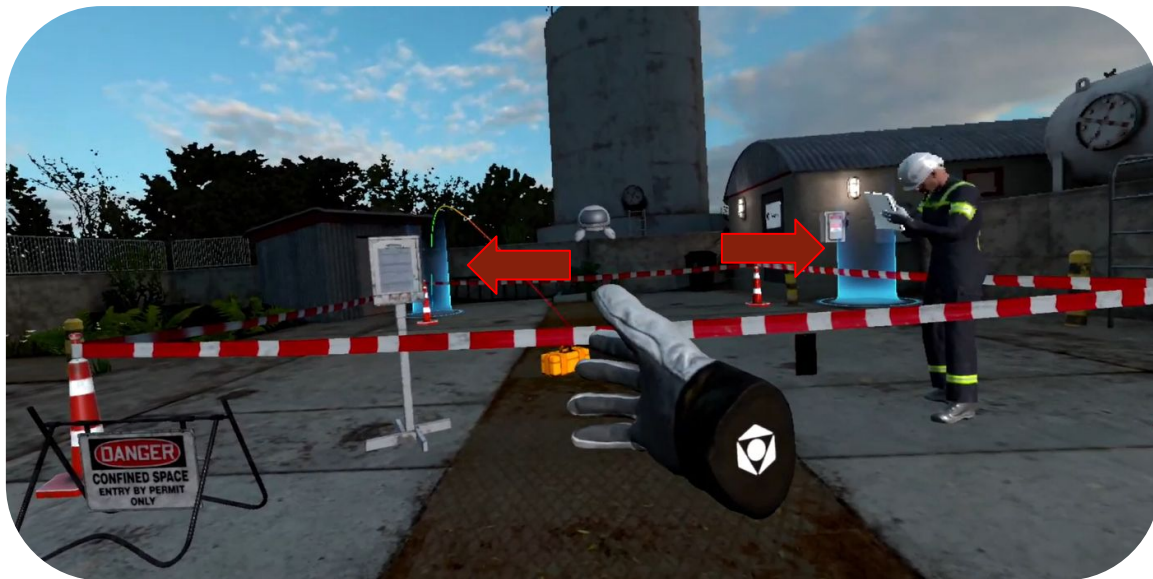
- When the trainee first puts on the headset, they might see a screen they are not supposed to be in. (pressing the wrong button, etc.)
- Ensure the Pixaera Lobby Screen is loaded, to allow the trainee to immediately launch the training.
- This prevents any confusion or uncertainty for those that do not have lot of experience with a VR headset.

Stop Work System



- Pixaera's LSR modules have a Stop Work button. This button is located on the bottom bar of your screen.
- This should be used when you spot a dangerous situation.

Teleportation



- As part of a module you might be required to Portal through the training to move to a different area of the module surroundings
- Please ensure you look out for the Blue portal to click to teleport.
